Privacy Policy

This privacy policy applies to your use of the G&CC Management Services Pvt Ltd and Gupta and Company website located at guptaconsultants.com, (hereafter known as G&CC), and G&CC applications complyvendor.com, saralcomply.com, but does not apply to any third party sites that may be linked to them, or any relationships you may have with the businesses listed on G&CC website/application.

1. Information we collect and use it by us
